

Saint of the Week

Saint John of God (1495-1550)

Saint John of God was canonized in 1690, and was later named the patron saint of hospitals and the sick.

Before his death, Saint John of God was a soldier, but later became a health-care worker. Inspired by his work, his followers later formed the Brothers Hospitallers of Saint John of God, a worldwide Catholic religious institute "serving the Church in the assistance for the sick and those in need, with a preference for the poorest".

Friday

First Reading Ezekiel 18:21-28

Do I take any pleasure in the death of the wicked? ... Rather, am I not pleased when they turn from their ways and live?

Responsorial Psalm Psalm 130:1-8

If you, Lord, kept a record of sins, who could stand? But with You, there is forgiveness ...

Friday of the First Week of Lent

Gospel Reading Matthew 5:20-26

... Leave your gift there in front of the altar. First go and be reconciled to them; then come and offer your gift.

Reflection Guide Question

Who is one person in your life who you need to reconcile with? Are you prepared to do so?

Challenge Of The Day

Today, talk with someone you need to forgive, or someone from whom you need to ask forgiveness.

Word of the Week

abstinence

/ˈabs-tə-nəns/



All Catholics aged 14 years old and above are called to practice abstinence during all Fridays of the Lenten season and refrain from eating meat.

The principle of abstinence, however, goes beyond simply avoiding meat in meals. In fact, Pope Francis warns us of the danger of practicing "many external observances" such as abstinence "without the truth of the heart".
